I am pleased to announce the release of the 2014 First Verse.

This is a bold wine which reflects the fine balance between terroir, climate and considered intervention.



The 2014 First Verse is a blend of 30% Merlot, 27% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Cabernet Franc, 16% Malbec and 3% Petit Verdot. The wine shows youthful and opulent blueberry and cassis fruit with hints of cedar wood spice on the nose. The palate follows with ripe, fleshy and intensely focused dark berry fruit with finely textured and juicy mouthfeel.

The 2014 First Verse is harmonious and elegant, finishing with polished tannins.

Internationally respected wine critic, Tim Atkin MW, rated this wine 96/100.
